- 1. It is compulsory to fulfill the following conditions in order to sit for the examination.
 - a) It is compulsory to have valid registration as mentioned above.
 - b) It is compulsory to pay all three course fee installments on or before the closing date.

If you failed to fulfill the above conditions in No: 01 you will not be eligible to apply for this examination.

- 2. Candidates who got the privileges by approved medical reasons for the previous examination held on April / May 2023. (Candidates who got the "MC" in the result sheet) should also apply for the repeat examination with payments.
- 3. Dully filled application and the payment receipt should be sent to the above address on or before 29th January 2024 through registered post. "Bachelor of Arts in English General (External) Degree Part III Repeat Examination" should be mentioned on the top left corner of envelope.
- 4. The **scanned copy of** duly filled Examination **applications** should be sent to the above-mentioned email address.
- 5. Specific account number will be generated for each applicant. Therefore, please make sure that you have paid to the correct account number provided to you and the incorrect payments will not be considered by the University. (Please keep a copy of payment voucher & bank slip).
- 6. Registered students those who have gone overseas are eligible to apply and appear for the examinations through online method (EDECU Online Distance Supervision Examinations)

For External Candidates

- 7.4 Candidates who have not sat/will not be sitting either for the full examination or for a part of it, due to an illness, have to inform the same to the Deputy Registrar or the Assistant Registrar of the External Examination and Extension Courses Unit with a certificate issued in this regard by a Government Hospital, prior to commencement of the Examination or during the Examination period.
- 7.5 If due to an unavoidable circumstance a candidate was unable to inform as stated above (7.4), he/she must forward a medical certificate from a Government Hospital in the area of his/her residence within 14 days of the commencement of the Examination or the part of the Examination. Certificates issued by Private Medical Practices run by Western, Ayurveda or Homeopathy doctors are not accepted.
